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STATE OF MISSISSIPPI GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995

The Joint Legislative Budget Committee feels that an explanation of the General Fund receipts anticipated and appropriations authorized for Fiscal Year 1995, as well as the ending balance anticipated on June 30, 1995, should be made in examining the schedule found in the Fiscal Year 1995 Appropriations Bulletin.

As you will note from the statement found on page three of the Bulletin, it is estimated that an unencumbered balance of \$3,301,576\$ will remain in the State Treasury on June 30, 1995.

The Fiscal Year 1994 appropriated figures contained in this report are the amounts actually appropriated by the 1993 Legislature and Extraordinary Legislative Session of 1993 plus all deficits and additionals appropriated by the 1994 Legislature.

Total current and deferred General Fund appropriations made by the 1994 Legislature amounted to \$2,519,534,930. The Legislature appropriated or authorized \$3,428,907,604 from Special Fund sources including Federal Funds for the operation of all General Fund agencies and functions during Fiscal Year 1995. The Fiscal Year 1995 budget is \$347,631,284 more than the Fiscal Year 1994 appropriated budget or an increase of 16.00%.

The General Fund budget increases and decreases by major categories as appropriated are for the following purposes:




